

In Christian communities, the start of the new church year begins four weeks before Christmas in a season called Advent. Through the course of the four weeks, we are reminded that there is joy amidst sorrow, hope amidst frustration, peace amidst conflict, love amidst hate and light amidst darkness. It is a season that reminds us we can and must be the purveyors of that joy, hope, peace, love and light. A consistent commitment to this lofty goal can certainly require a lot of self-discipline, diligence and persistence. Christians rely on God's word for guidance and strength to help them in their efforts to show kindness, friendship, compassion, forgiveness and love of our neighbor.

In 2017, the Pew Research Group published a study that revealed that at least 90% of Americans celebrate Christmas in some form. Fifty five percent of those surveyed said they celebrated Christmas as a religious holiday, 33% celebrated it as a cultural holiday and 9% celebrated it as both. So how do we celebrate Christmas as a 'cultural holiday'? Gift giving is a huge part of the cultural aspect. Holiday sales this year are expected to balloon to \$720 billion. In comparison, the Reuters foundation released a study this year that indicated that world hunger could be eradicated with \$270 billion a year. Roughly eight-in-ten Americans say they intend to gather with family and friends on Christmas Eve or Christmas Day. On the other hand, 16% will be alone or displaced during the holidays.

In essence, let us all, regardless of Christian or cultural practice, draw on our inner strengths and think about what matters most during this holiday season and throughout the year. We can all offer gifts, not necessarily monetary, such as hospitality, kindness, compassion, forgiveness and care for our families and neighbors that will result joy, hope, peace, love and light.





Did you know?

1. Kwanzaa traces its origins o Africa and is celebrated cross North America and other nations that have large opulations that trace their hertage to Africa. The holiday begins on December 26 and ontinues until January 1. The nain components of the celevration include family, commuvity and culture. Kwanzaa was not designed to replace Christnas. In fact, many Kwanzaa elebrants also celebrate Christnas. The word "kwanzaa" is rom the Swahili phrase Matunda ya kwanza," which neans "first fruits." Maulana Karenga, the professor who creted the holiday in 1966, chose wahili as the language associited with the holiday because it sn't affiliated with a particular African region or tribe. At the neart of the holiday are seven vrinciples that celebrants emvrace and follow: unity, self-decollective ermination, esponsibility, cooperative ecoiomics, purpose, creativity, and aith. Even though the holiday vas created for African Amerians, many other ethnic groups re inspired by the foundations of Kwanzaa and choose to join n the festivities.

2. What would Christmas ;ift-giving be without a tree

under which to place the presents? Tree shoppers have plenty of variety to choose from when selecting that ideal tree. Approximately 21,000 Christmas tree farms exist in the United States, and these farms sell between 30 and 35 million real trees each year. Those who prefer artificial trees can shop for everything from trees that appear to be natural to pastelhued boughs. The first printed reference to a Christmas tree was made in 1531 in Germany. Since then, Christmas trees have grown in popularity through the centuries.

3. As holiday shopping season kicks into high gear, retailers who use apps and mobile responsive websites to reach more customers may benefit by making a concerted effort to reach older shoppers. According to Nielsen's Mobile Measurement, 26 percent of the more than 100 million mobile shoppers are 55 and older, while an additional 40 percent are between the ages of 25 and 44. Those figures might surprise some retailers who are quick to associate mobile shopping with digital-native Millennials. Nielsen's Fourth-Quarter 2014 Mobile Multicultural Insights report even

noted that Hispanics are more inclined to shop via mobile than non-Hispanic, white smartphone owners. Retailers may also be interested to know that more and more shoppers are turning to apps instead of websites to do their shopping. Between the fourth quarter of 2013 and the fourth quarter of 2014, Nielsen reports that 101.4 million smartphone users accessed a shopping app. By the fourth quarter of 2015, that figure had risen to 109.9 million users.
